

GEARS at Greenville First Christian Church routes All routes begin at the church, 1100 Killarney Drive in Greenville. With the exception of the 8-mile loop, the map is drawn with the assumption you will begin the loops by turning left on Route 140, then turning right on Red Ball Trail. The 8-mile loop, marked in orange, remains straight on Idler Lane. For more detailed maps of Greenville, see the second and third pages.


## Departing Greenville First Christian Church

Take Killarney out of the church lot, wind through a residential area, then then turn left on Idler. At the intersection of Idler and Illinois Route 140, you can either stay straight or turn left, depending on which way you want to ride the loops. The map on the first page is drawn -- except for the 8-mile loop marked in orange -with the assumption you will turn left on Route 140, then turn right on Red Ball Trail. The 8-mile loop leaves and enters Greenville on Idler Lane.

For most routes, you will return to the church the same way you left. If you are taking the 23-mile loop that goes through Woburn and Smithboro, see the next page.


# Returning to Greenville First Christian Church from the 23-mile Woburn-Smithboro loop 

When you return to Greenville, you will cross U.S. Route 40 and Illinois Route 127 on Bowman Industrial Drive. Stay on Bowman until you get to Elm Street at the Greenville College soccer fields. Turn right on Elm, cross railroad tracks, then cross Route 127/Harris Avenue at the light. Go to Greenville College, turn right there onto College Avenue, then go to left on Dewey Street. the Jaycee park is on both sides of the street, and the church shortly thereafter on the left at 1100 Killarney Drive. If you pass the grade school, you have gone too far.
